# Overview of the Program

## *Start Your Global Leadership Journey in Korea (Fully Funded)*



The **G-20 Global Leadership Program** was launched after Korea's hosting of the G20 Leaders Summit in 2010. The program aims to bring together experienced managers and stakeholders from various ministries and government agencies who are dedicated to advancing G-20 development goals.

The objective of the program is to enhance the participant's ability to contribute to economic growth and to drive momentum to realize actual change in one's country. Participation in the program is basically free of charge and all eligible persons may apply.

# Program Structure

This is a blended program that will be offered using online and offline methodology. The online lectures will include lessons from Korea's development experience and G20 agenda issues. The Field Study to Korea will provide in-depth discussions with the speakers and fellow G20 participants, and visits to significant industrial, historic and cultural sites.

## Online Courses

- Topic: 2022 G20 priority issues
- Delivery Method: Zoom Live Streaming
- Duration: April 27th – June 10th, 2022 (KST)  
→ one lecture (1.5 hours) per week

## Offline Field Study

- Objective: Understanding Korea's development experiences by visiting relevant sites
- Place: Korea
- Duration: Tentatively scheduled for July and October 2022 (details will depend on COVID-19 travel restrictions)



# Eligibility Requirements

- Currently in-service or working as a leader, change agent, or facilitator in promoting global development or on G20 matters
- Minimum of **three years** of work experience
- Fluency in **English**
- Able to attend live streaming courses and travel to Korea if travel restrictions permit it
